Appendix 'C': League Cup and Playoff Tournaments

Rules applied to League Cup and Playoff tournament BSL sanctioned games shall be the same as that of the league except for:

- a) The duration of the game is to be the same as the league, unless the game ends in a tie after the regulation time.
- b) If a game prior to the finals ends in a tie, penalty kicks will be taken as follows:
 - i) Only the players on the field at the final whistle shall be eligible to take part in the taking of penalty kicks.
 - ii) With the exception of both goalkeepers and the player taking the penalty kick, all players must remain within the centre circle.
 - iii) Five (5) penalty kicks will be taken alternately by different players on the teams. If after five (5) penalty kicks the teams are still tied, each team will take alternated kicks by members who have not yet taken a penalty kick, until one team has scored and the other misses.
- c) If the final ends in a tie, thirty minutes extra time (2 X 15 minute halves) will be played. If after extra time the game is still tied, the result shall be settled using the penalty kick method as described in paragraph 'b' above.
- d) If, during regulation time, a game is abandoned the provisions of By-law 15 shall apply. If the abandonment takes place during the taking of penalty kicks the result will be decided by the toss of a coin. If a game is tied when abandoned, the result will be decided by the toss of a coin.
- e) Transferred player(s) who have previously completed in a League Cup and/or Playoff competition for another team are ineligible to take further part in the same competition with their new team.
